Back To Business – It's YOUR Time - August 25, 2017

Free Bus Passes:

If your high school student is on the Free /Reduced Meal Program, they might be eligible for a free monthly bus pass. For a student to receive a free monthly bus pass they must:

1. Provide documentation of qualification for Free and Reduced Lunch Program
2. Live more than 1.5 miles from school- this is the address of record, if two households.
3. Do not reside on a 4J school bus route
4. Buss Pass must be picked up by 15th of each month.

If your student qualifies for a free bus pass and is new to SEHS please bring a copy of your student's 2016-17 or 2017-2018 "Notice of Approval for School Meals" to the Finance Office. If needed, call Nutrition Services at 541-790-7656 to obtain a copy of your "Letter of Eligibility". To continue eligibility before receiving the October bus pass a student **MUST** show their 2017-18 "Notice of Approval for School Meals". Free/Reduced applications for the 2017-18 school year can be submitted starting July 1, 2016. Apply on line at <http://www.4j.lane.edu/nutrition/>.

The benefits go beyond savings on school meals and bus passes. Here are just a few of the opportunities available to students and families who qualify for free or reduced-price school meals:

Sprint Cell Phone Program- Free cell phone, service plan, hot spot for other connections.

Drivers Training Scholarships – Check with the Finance Office when your student registers for a Session with Oregon Driver Training Institute.

Reduced fees for sports, activities and summer camps: Your student can qualify for fee reductions of up to 80 percent on 4J athletics and activity fees. Other organizations that offer reduced registration fees for youth recreation and enrichment programs include Kidsports, Eugene Family YMCA, the City of Eugene, River Road Parks and Recreation District, and many others.

Low-cost Internet access and computer: Comcast Internet Essentials offers high-speed Internet service for \$9.95 a month plus tax to households in which at least one child qualifies for the school meal program. Free or low-cost healthcare coverage: Oregon Healthy Kids provides no-cost health coverage for Oregon children and teens under 19 years of age. Healthy Kids covers all health needs. Children will not be turned away due to pre-existing conditions or be put on a waiting list. You do *not* need to qualify for free or reduced-price school meals to qualify. Half Price Admission at Amazon, Echo Hollow, and Sheldon City of Eugene Pools: Any children who use the 4J free or reduced lunch program qualify for half priced admission for recreation swim at the Amazon, Echo Hollow, and Sheldon City of Eugene pools. Aid for college-bound students: Students who qualify for the school meal program can receive a fee reduction or waiver for SAT, ACT, Advanced Placement and IB tests. They also can receive free additional score reports for some tests and can request a waiver or deferral of application fees at many colleges.
