### School and Community

South Eugene High School is located in Eugene, Oregon, nestled in the southern Willamette Valley between the Cascade Mountains and the Coast Range, with an approximate population of 163,000. A high percentage of residents are employed in the medical, educational and professional fields. Eugene's vibrant community is active in the arts and out-of-doors, and is a world-recognized center for track & field, hosting events such as the Olympic Trials. The public education system is strongly supported by Eugene voters.

*The French Immersion Program at South Eugene High School and Eugene International High School is distinguished as one of few public immersion high schools in the United States and is nationally recognized for academic excellence.*

This unique K-12 program began in 1984. It is a magnet program, focused on developing fluency and using French in interdisciplinary studies. French Immersion is a rigorous program in which students complete up to 50% of coursework in French over thirteen years. In oral and written fluency most French Immersion students already perform at levels equivalent to university-level French majors.
