

College & Career Readiness Day

Wednesday October 16th

All teachers, inform students about activities and expectations for this day during 2nd period Monday 10/14 & again Tuesday 10/15

CCR Day is an important school day and attendance will be taken. In the morning students will participate in activities to promote Personalized Learning and post-high school planning, which is a high school graduation requirement.

In the afternoon (1:20-2:48) teachers will be scheduling meetings with students to provide help or to makeup missing work. Teachers will also be available to students for individualized help.

9th Grade – Freshman Basics

At 8:30 am report to assigned classroom. Finish at 12:45 pm.

Freshman will rotate as a group through three different sessions covering healthy relationships via Respect Ed, Naviance Course Planning and goal setting, and strategies to be healthy successful students. Students will also learn about our many Career & Technical Education (CTE) opportunities, meeting a panel of South CTE students.

10th Grade – PSAT Test

At 8:30 am report to assigned classroom. Finish at 12:45 pm

This is a practice for the SAT college admission test. Practice booklets are available in the Career Center. The booklets will help students become familiar with the wording of questions, answer format and instruction process prior to taking the test. **Students should bring a picture ID, two #2 pencils (not mechanical), scientific calculator, a snack, & a book.**

11th Grade PSAT/NMSQT or Presentation and Workshops (2 options)

1. PSAT Test: At 8:30 am report to assigned classroom. Finish at 12:45 pm.

This is a practice for the SAT & also the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship Program. Pick up a practice booklet in the Career Center. Juniors must have registered & paid to take the PSAT. Verify that your name is on the posted, PSAT list. Students should bring a picture ID, two #2 pencils (not mechanical), scientific calculator, a snack, & a book.

2. Presentation & Workshops: At 8:30 am report to the Little Theatre for junior class presentation and then attend 3 workshops of their choosing. All juniors who did not register and pay for the PSAT by Oct. 1st will attend Option #2. **Finish at 12:45 pm.**

12th Grade – Senior Meeting & Workshops

At 8:30 am report to the Auditorium for information on ordering the diploma, cap, & gown and **graduation essentials**. Then attend 3 workshops. The workshops will address a wide range of interests geared toward post high school plans. See “Senior Workshop Schedule” for details. For many seniors, 1 of the 3 workshops will be assigned based on the students plan for completing Personalized Learning. Workshops with a "⌘"symbol are Senior Experience/ personalized learning approved! **Finish at 12:45 pm.**

* CTE students must complete a Mock Interview for one of their three sessions.

* IHS students should attend an IHS Senior Paper Workshop.

Seniors & juniors attending workshops receive a “Passport” in their first session, get it stamped after each session, and leave it with the last presenter or in the main office to verify attendance.
