TECHNOLOGY

1. We encourage everyone to utilize the links to [Canvas](#) and [StudentVue](#) from the [4j District website](#) or the [SEHS website](#).
2. Always make sure you are logged in with your 4J account.
3. Try from a different platform. For example, if you were trying from Google Chrome, for your second attempt try Firefox or Safari.
4. If Zoom links are not working or there is not one to be found on the class Canvas page, email your teacher asap and let them know.
5. Visit the [4j District website](#) to either call or ‘Submit a Ticket’ to get tech help. Once on the 4j District website, hover over the ‘Students’ tab and click ‘Student Tech Support’. Once you have clicked on “Submit a Ticket” you will be asked a series of questions that will help the Tech Support Team resolve your issue. 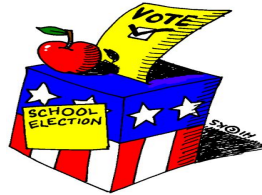

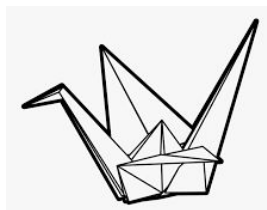
