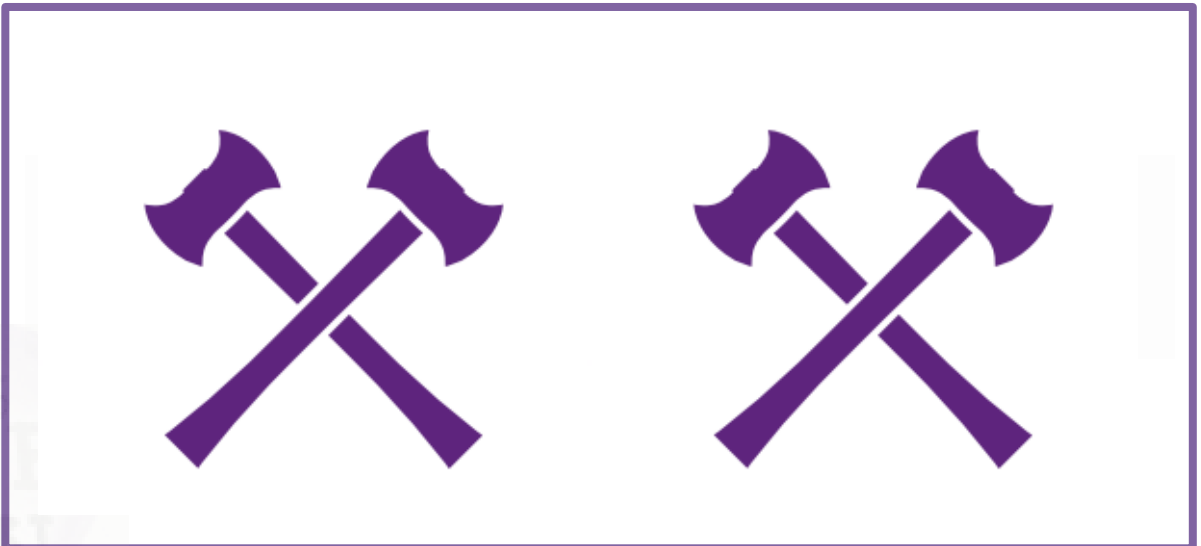

The drive will take place **December 16 - 17 during textbook drop-off.**

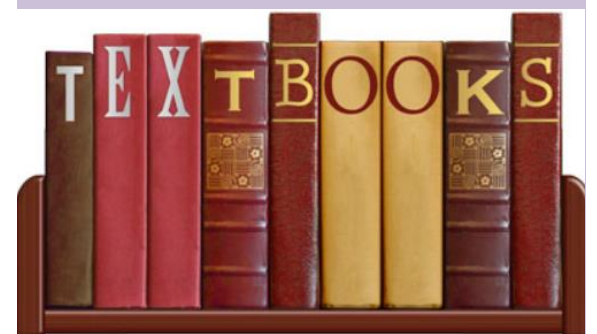
