Because COVID restrictions prevented in-person registration and school photos last fall, we don't have our usual bank of underclassmen photos for the yearbook.

We're inviting students, grades 9th – 11th, to submit your own school pictures this year. [Here is the submission link.](#)

Read the instructions carefully, keeping these guidelines in mind:

- Print dimensions in the yearbook are roughly 1" wide by 1.5" high. Resizing images to about 2" x 3" (600 x 900 pixels) gives us plenty of room to crop the photo in the layout.
- Digital images translate best when the resolutions is 300 dpi or 600 x 900 pixels in digital dimensions.
- We would prefer that images be free of filters and/or props.
- This does not have to be a studio quality portrait. It can be a favorite photo from the last few months or a snapshot by a friend or family member.
- We will evaluate selfies on a case by case basis, but we discourage them in specifications for senior photos.

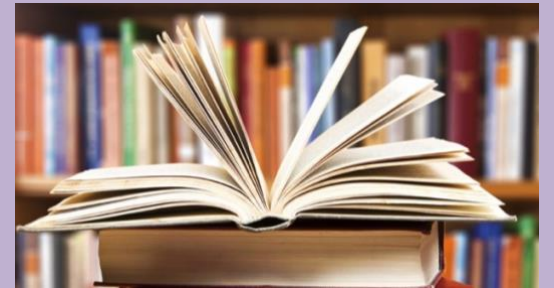
