2022-2023 FRENCH IMMERSION PROGRAM @ South Eugene & International High School

The French Immersion Program at South Eugene High School and Eugene International High School is distinguished as one of few public immersion high schools in the United States and is nationally recognized for academic excellence.

This unique program began in 1984. It is an alternative pathway in the Eugene 4j School District, focused on developing fluency and using French in interdisciplinary studies. French Immersion is a rigorous program in which students complete up to 50% of coursework in French over thirteen years. In oral and written fluency most French Immersion students already perform at levels equivalent to university-level French majors. French Immersion students have demonstrated exceptional commitment and perseverance in this challenging program.
